In order to offer the best educational opportunities possible for children of the district, the board will seek revenue sources to supplement the funds provided through local taxation and state and federal aid.

All applications for grants will be in accordance with the educational philosophy and goals set by the board of directors. Any portion of the application or final report dealing with financial or legal issues will be checked and approved by the principal before being submitted to any outside agency. Copies of all application and final reports will be filed in the district office.

All grants received by the board will be properly deposited and accounted for by the administrator or designee of the school district and will be administered in accordance with the terms of the grant. The administrator or designee may, with board approval, assign program and/or account administration to an external agency in keeping with guidelines established by the funding source or the board.

No such funds, other than the long-term trust funds, will earn or accrue their own interest, nor will the district pay for fund held, except by specific board action.
